


Ceremonial Components

- Energetic attunement to place, purpose, and participants seen and unseen.
- Personal relevance. Alive for participants...Living Ceremony.
- Co-creative synergy.
- Focused celebratory attention.

Ceremonial Energies



Ceremonies can be simple or complex.
Created for one person, a small group,
or a large crowd.

Ceremonies bridge the conscious and

way.



Honor

- **Milestones:** Initiation or other completions (graduations), marriage, birth.
- **Transitions:** Loss of a job, divorce, change of life, death.
- **Deep Inner Healing.**
- **Boost success with creation focus.**
- **Honoring rhythms of Wheel of the Year and/or a moon phase.**

Basic Ceremonial Outline

Order and components are flexible.

Ceremony Creation

1. Determine the Intention for the ceremony.
2. Determine participants.
3. Determine location.
4. Create Structure of the ceremony. Include participants, place, intention, and each elemental realm.

Day and Time of the Ceremony

1. Prepare space. Create focal point and any other necessary components. Leave ceremonial space in better condition than you found it.
2. Prepare yourself. Prepare participants if needed.

Ceremony Itself

1. Enter ceremonial space.
2. Call in sacred space.
3. Initial Connection and Intention.
4. Body of Ceremony including each elemental realm.
 - Earth
 - Water
 - Air
 - Fire
 - Spirit
5. Raise Energy.
6. Distribute energy appropriately.
7. Ground energy.

Raising the Energy of Celebration

- Uplifts each person and community
- Imprints in cells
- Energetic Sustainability



Sacred Space

- Just as you create a sacred place or physical space for an event or ceremony you also create a sacred mental/emotional/energetic/spiritual internal space.
- Importance in your own work and holding space for others.
- You may or may not be doing ceremony with others.

Earth Physical Realm

- Physical Space
- Physical Safety
- Physical Connection
- Physical Ceremonies such as burial.



Water Emotional Realm

- Emotional Connection
- Emotional Safety
- Harmonic cord in feeling realm
- Water in Ceremony such as using holy water or baptism.



Air Mental Realm

- Ceremonial Intent
- Keeping the Focus
- Calling on the Unseen
- Mental Safety
- Air in Ceremony
- Utilizing the power of word.



Fire Action Realm

- **Keeping Ceremony Energized**
- **Utilizing the energy of the Ceremony**
- **Utilizing Activation**
- **Fire in Ceremony burning objects, candle-light, sacred fire, trance or altered states.**
