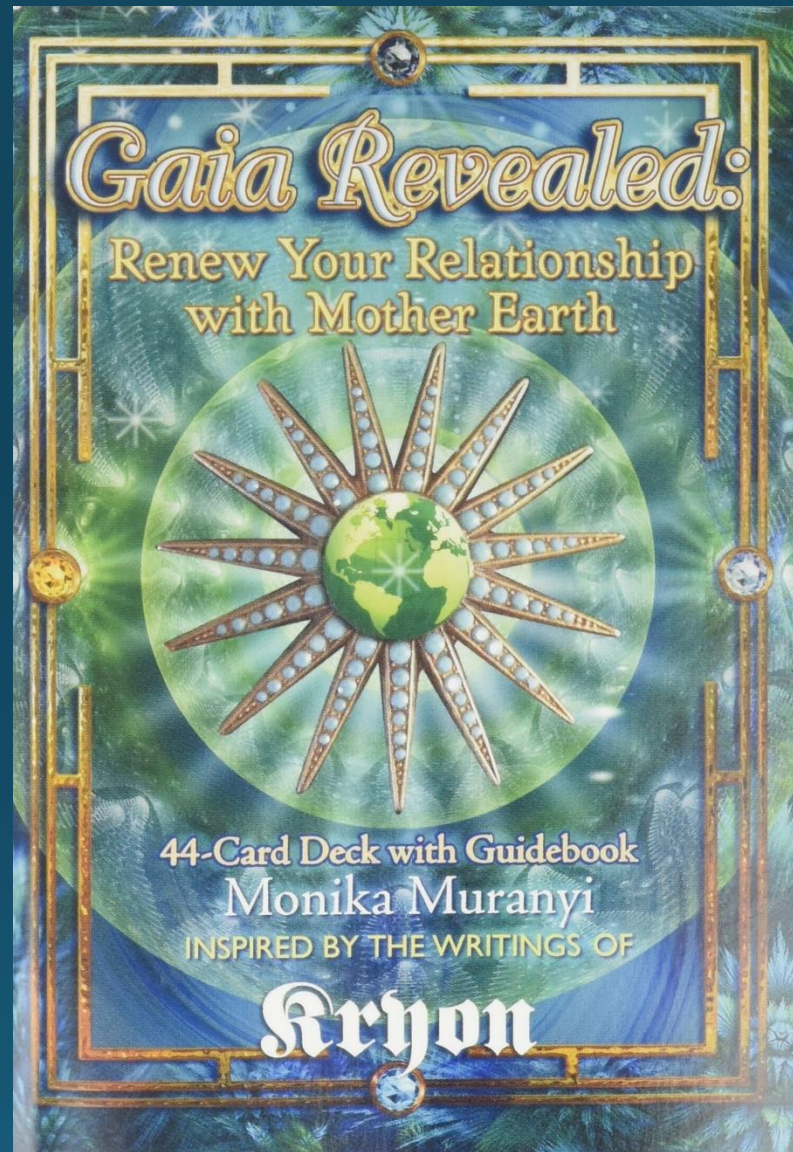

Living Ceremony

The Potency (immediate and long term, personal and universal) of any ritual or ceremony is proportional to the participants' sustained, focused consciousness and intent preceding, during, and after the activity.



Ceremonial Components

- Energetic attunement to place, purpose, and participants seen and unseen.
- Personal relevance. Alive for participants...Living Ceremony.
- Co-creative synergy.
- Focused celebratory attention.

Ceremonial Energies



Ceremonies can be simple or complex.
Created for one person, a small group,
or a large crowd.

Ceremonies bridge the conscious and
subconscious mind in a very powerful
way.



Honor

- **Milestones:** Initiation or other completions (graduations), marriage, birth.
- **Transitions:** Loss of a job, divorce, change of life, death.
- **Deep Inner Healing.**
- **Boost success with creation focus.**
- **Honoring rhythms of Wheel of the Year and/or a moon phase.**

Working with Intention

- What you do want to energize in your ceremony?
- Ceremony intent becomes the focus.



Basic Ceremonial Outline

Order and components are flexible.

Ceremony Creation

1. Determine the Intention for the ceremony.
2. Determine participants.
3. Determine location.
4. Create Structure of the ceremony. Include participants, place, intention, and each elemental realm.

Day and Time of the Ceremony

1. Prepare space. Create focal point and any other necessary components. Leave ceremonial space in better condition than you found it.
2. Prepare yourself. Prepare participants if needed.

Ceremony Itself

1. Enter ceremonial space.
2. Call in sacred space.
3. Initial Connection and Intention.
4. Body of Ceremony including each elemental realm.

5. Raise Energy.

- You may or may not be doing ceremony with others.



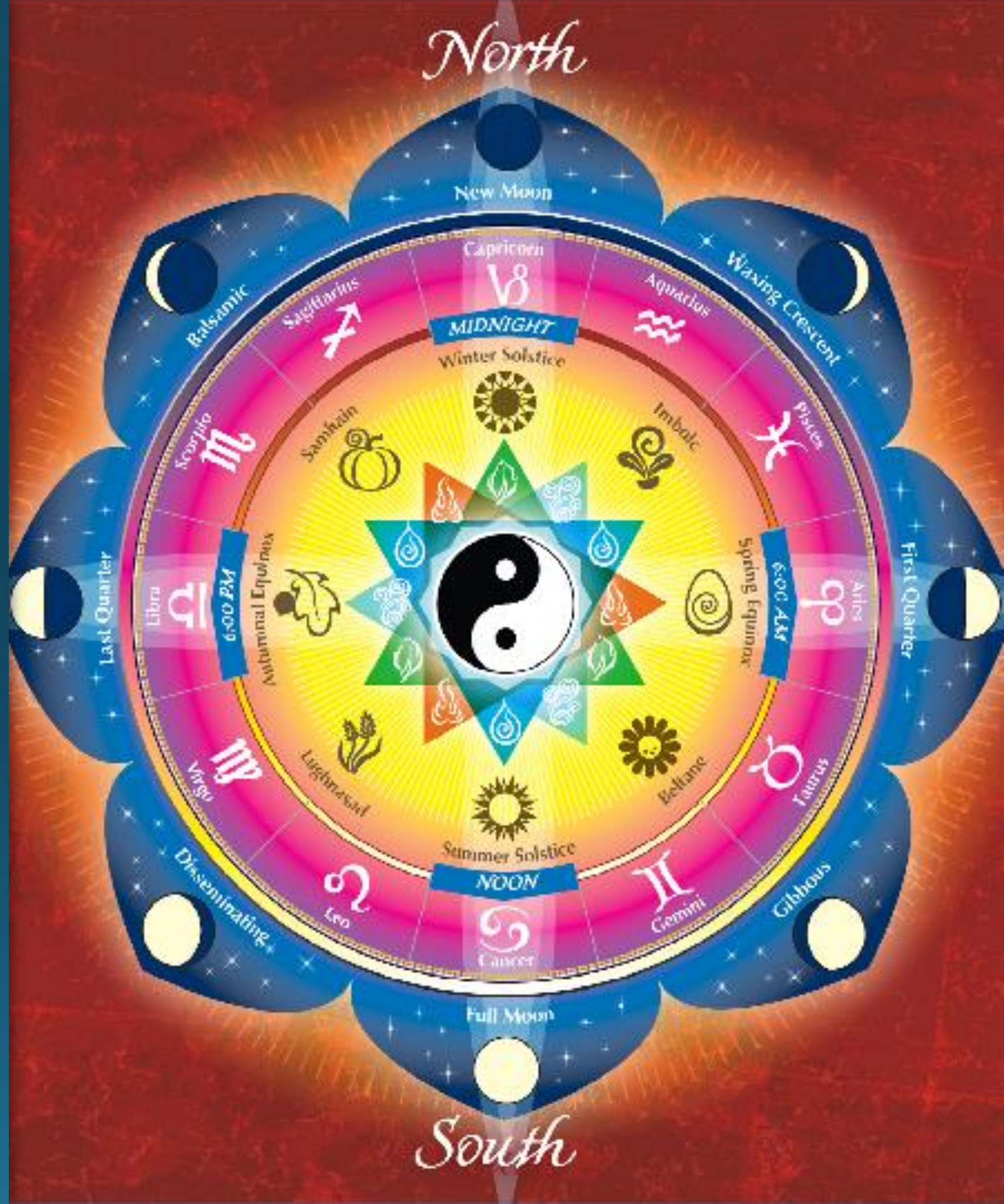
Earth in sacred space

- Connecting to and working with your clients and on/in your business.



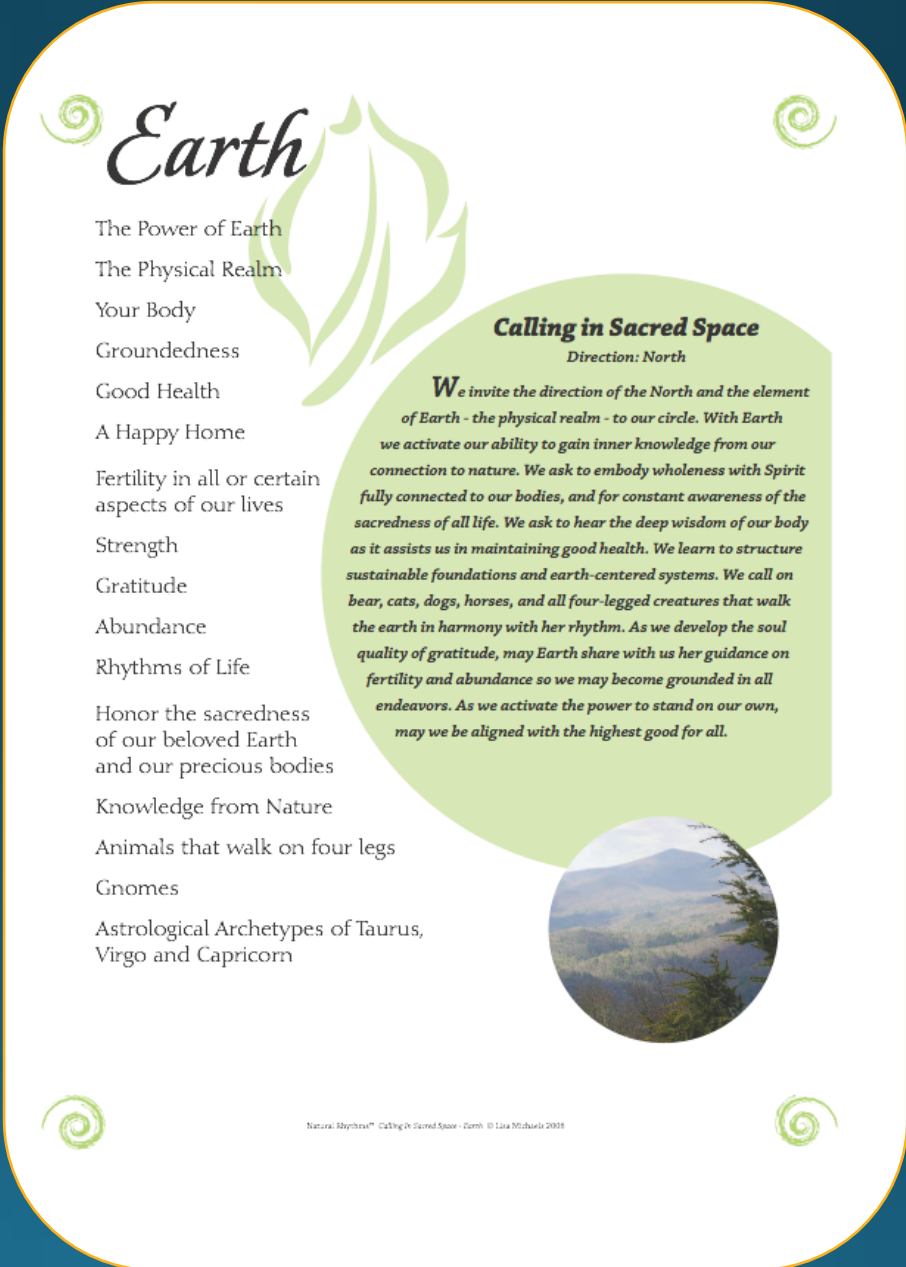

Calling in Sacred Space
Direction: North

We invite the direction of the North and the element of Earth - the physical realm - to our circle. With Earth we activate our ability to gain inner knowledge from our connection to nature. We ask to embody wholeness with Spirit fully connected to our bodies, and for constant awareness of the sacredness of all life. We ask to hear the deep wisdom of our body as it assists us in maintaining good health. We learn to structure sustainable foundations and earth-centered systems. We call on bear, cats, dogs, horses, and all four-legged creatures that walk the earth in harmony with her rhythm. As we develop the soul quality of gratitude, may Earth share with us her guidance on fertility and abundance so we may become grounded in all endeavors. As we activate the power to stand on our own, may we be aligned with the highest good for all.

Calling in Sacred Space
Direction: South

We invite the direction of the South and the element of Water - the emotional realm - to our circle. With Water we activate our emotional maturity and ask to have the wisdom to respond, instead of to react, to life. We ask that our emotional realm be clear, clean, and current. We invite the spirit of the lakes, rivers, streams, oceans, and rain to join us. We invite the dolphins, whales, fish, mermaids, and water sprites to our circle. We honor our inner child, the deep teachings of the mirror of relationships, and the potency of regeneration. We activate and align the Water power of love with the highest good for all.

Calling in Sacred Space

Direction: West

We ask to see the cosmic and archetypal perspective of our personal and mass consciousness belief systems. We open to deep listening to one another. As we call on the birds and the winged ones, we ask for the courage to be the visionaries for our time. We call on the angelic realm and all those who assist us on the inner realm to guide our path. We claim the Air power of intention and align our intentions with the highest good of all.

Direction: Center

We invite the direction of Center and Spirit to our circle. We honor both the Divine Feminine and Divine Masculine. We activate the As Above/So Below Mysteries and the As Within/So Without Mysteries. We call on the deep wisdom of the yin and yang, receptive and active forces. We ask to align the forces within toward inner balance, allowing the wisdom and rhythm of the sun and moon to guide our own lives. We call on all those connected to sacred union: Goddess and God, Magdalene and Christ, Gaia and Green Man, Isis and Osirus, Shakti and Shiva. We call forth our own inner essence and ask that our expression in the world be toward the highest good of all. May we use our power of choice wisely, and may we have compassion for all life. May we grow in our ability to activate a unified field of awareness, bringing forth our Spirit filled desires with grace and ease.
